Preamble

The international community is increasingly interested in supporting efforts at more than one level to promote dialogue between cultures, alliance between civilizations and coexistence between peoples, out of a concern to build a new world where values of tolerance based on mutual respect prevail, and sport of all kinds and branches is regarded as one of the tools of entertainment and a means of building and achieving a balance between a person's physical, psychological and mental structure, as well as being an effective means of bringing peoples and nations closer together, acting as a bridge to improve understanding between different countries and cultivating a culture of peaceful coexistence.

Sports physical activity is of great importance in the formation and construction of the individual in the light of conflicts and different cultures, which may have religious backgrounds or multiple intellectual references. However, on the other hand, we must not forget that sport, and in particular physical and sports activity, through its subversive use, in some cases, has been a negative factor in relations between many peoples and states, and sometimes it (sport) has played a role in provoking hostility, which has been embodied in certain examples in which the fire of hatred has been kindled and feelings of hatred and hostility have arisen and multiplied until they have reached the point of starting wars in cases that have marked contemporary history.

However, the primary task entrusted to sports bodies, Olympic committees, the boards of sports clubs in various countries, and to those responsible for the media in general and the sports media in particular, is to filter out the deposits of hatred and resentment in people's souls, and to work in a systematic and studied manner, and in coordination between official bodies, sports and media bodies and institutions of the civil community, in order to build an advanced state of awareness in the citizens of countries with regard to the role of sport in bringing peoples closer together and overcoming riots in stadiums by using sports events as festive events capable of fostering communication between peoples, sport also seeks to focus on what is common to different cultures because of its role in strengthening the bonds of friendship between young people, the development of skills and talents in particular, and the development of sport in general, which further expands the common space historically, linguistically, culturally and civilizationally with the aim of advancing the sport sector.


Objectives of the international conference

This international conference deals with the analysis and study of the communication process in sport, and the repercussions of this process on the development of the sport system in Algeria, and there's no doubt that these days, sports communication plays a fundamental role in the development of the sports movement, and the sports system in Algeria has suffered from a clear deficit in the communication field, and this has had a negative impact on the sports teams performance, as certain negative phenomena have appeared and worsened, such as doping to win and obtain results without respecting any sports value, as well as the phenomena of riots and violence in various sections of sports competitions, particularly football, which enjoys great popularity with young people.

The sports system in Algeria has also suffered from a lack of sound management in the various sports clubs and associations, and even in the various leagues organizing the sports movement, due to a lack of skills and managerial abilities.

The lack of respect for modern management methods such as transparency, coordination and the media, and the absence of sports communication in the reality of sports teams, lead to certain negative aspects, in particular the transmission of unreliable information and its use for instigation purposes within the public, the lack of transparency in the transmission of financial and moral balance sheets, and the lack of coordination and organization between the different clubs and sports bodies, all of these negative phenomena distance the communication process from its noble objectives. We have therefore decided to organize this conference entitled "Sport is an opening onto the world and a bridge for civilizational communication", which aims to:

- Bring together intellectuals, experts and people concerned by the issues raised in the conference to discuss ways of adopting a method of reducing practices that hinder the communication process.
- Open up interaction and dialogue between the various international and regional sports organizations and bodies.
- Acquire local and regional cooperation, such as Arab, African and international sports communication with European countries, in order to make this communication more effective and raise it to the level of coordination, knowledge and integration.
- Stress the importance of disseminating ethical values that help release the latent capacities of researchers in the field of sport.
- Pay attention to new ideas, the exchange of experiences and the activation of relationships in order to encourage participants to engage in future intellectual conferences.
- Access scientific and technical expertise and research results presented to contribute to the development and enrichment of fields related to the conference themes.
- To exchange knowledge and experience between members of the teaching profession and specialist sports bodies.
- To establish and disseminate a culture of peace through sports activities within and outside the country.



International conference themes (axes) and fields

Eighth theme: Sports management and quality parameters.

Ninth theme: The reality of physical sports activity in the light of the development guidelines of New Algeria.

Arabic is the official language of the international scientific conference, but participating speakers (lecturers) may make their presentations in both languages (French, English).




Research Submission Details

The research submissions for the international conference must meet the following criteria:

- The research should align with one of the international conference themes and objectives.
- The research should adhere to the commonly accepted standards of scientific publishing in academic journals.
- It should not have been previously published in a specialized scientific journal or submitted to another international conference.
- The research should follow the APA (American Psychological Association) citation style.
- Submissions will be evaluated by the international conference's scientific committee according to established scientific principles.
- Each submission should include an abstract in Arabic and another in either English or French.
- The research should be between 10 and 15 pages in length, with a font size of 14 for Simplified Arabic in the case of Arabic language, and font size 12 for Times New Roman in the case of foreign languages.
- Accepted research will be published in the international conference proceedings after incorporating any requested revisions by the researchers.
